Since 2003, Prof. Catapano has been the Director of the Institute of Oncology Research (IOR). He is also Head of the Laboratory of Experimental Therapeutics, and responsible for the Tumor Biology and Experimental Therapeutics Program at IOR. Prof. Catapano is the author of several scientific publications. His research aims to discover innovative strategies for cancer cure by understanding the complex genetic, epigenetic, and metabolic processes underpinning cancer evolution, stem cell biology, and treatment resistance.
